Board approved the checks unanimously.

180K budget, have only spent about 37K which is 20 percent of the budget.

Toni has 66K in the Tiger Fund, versus Sara's 50K, we think that it is the 66K due to paypal monies coming in that Sara does not see.

Next year we are in a good financial position, we have raised about 95K, which is great considering the pandemic.

We have 143K left in our budget, however there could be checks coming in to reimburse the teachers.

About 128K after we pay the teachers back, plus the 92K that will roll over to next year. We did not spend a lot of money this year, so we will operate at normal levels next year. Question about the black top, turns out that the district is going to pay for the black top. Yay!

Lauren reported that next fall we will do PE, Art and some type of music or drama.

8. Principal's report – Mike Taylor (10 Minutes)

MT followed up with his report.

- Plans to return to full day are approved by the district, teachers are on board. Will look similar to the way it does now, just a longer day. Will only happen if we go to yellow on May 4.
- Not sure if we are going to yellow tomorrow, there might be some numbers that will not allow it, which will make the plan be pushed back.
