4. Principal's Report - Alex Peck (15 min)

Welcome back, we hope you had a fun and relaxing winter break. We were happy to be back at school today. Yesterday, Monday, January 6th was a professional development day. Teachers participated in continuing education, part of which was learning about data-driven techniques and explored ways to appropriately incorporate AI into the classroom.

Library update... we have new book shelves in our library, partially funded by Coleman PTO! Come check out the new Coleman library, it's looking great!

Initial iReady data: Mid-year, seeing YOY growth when comparing scores from this year vs. last year. Coleman has seen growth over the last 3 years which is great, we are seeing growth above state averages but below the rate we want to see at Coleman so there's still work for us to do.

Teachers will continue to use the remaining teacher work days to work on lesson plans and utilize Common Formative Assessments - 6 week cycles to look at data to allow the teacher to quickly check to confirm if their students are understanding the concepts to determine if they need to re-teach or if they can continue moving forward with concepts and lessons. Lots of exciting things are happening within our classrooms, our students are working really hard and so are our teachers, and we're seeing the results academically.

Black History Month Celebrations will begin in February. Teachers will be reaching out to families to ask for support for these activities. Big focus of the week is around STEAM, students will learn about contributions Black scientists have made throughout history. Students will engage developmentally age appropriate STEAM activities each day during the first week of February. Campus update: we are moving forward with using the Dominican Maintenance and Operations parking lot for recess blacktop play space.
