Call to Order — Bridget Radachy called the meeting to order at 6:02pm

2. Approve Minutes

a. Approved Board Minutes from 9/26/16

3. **Principal's Report** – *Mike Taylor*

- a. **Halloween Celebration** will be on a Monday, day after Run for the Gold. Normal day until after lunch. 1:10pm kids change, 1:30 K leads parade and picks up other grades. After parade, back to classes for parties. Recess at 2:45 with regular dismissal.
- b. **Coleman School Mission** is a work in progress and close to completion. Have identified Goals, Core Values and Actions. Compiled staff and parent ideas. Requesting further feedback. Turn into Mike's office.

4. **PTO Business** – *Bridget Radachy*

a. PTO will be spending \$7,000 on Enrichment

- i. Let's get more art on campus and build community. \$4K goes to mural and remaining funds will go into holding, perhaps for Student Council to decide on, TBD. Ideas of peek-a-boo murals or smaller scale installations sprinkled throughout campus. Applying STEAM principles through concept, design, feedback and implementation. Budget will include supplies and Tori Berghoff's time. Possibly 20-30 kids, but open to more. Looking for more sponsorship.
- ii. Mike makes a motion to spend the money to move the mural project forward. Board approved motion.
- iii. Mike makes a second motion to create a team to allocate the remainder of enrichment money. Board approved motion. See Mike to be a part of this committee.

5. **Treasurer's Report** – *Jon Haveman*

a. Net income is down about \$7K, Scrip is down a bit. Most other budgets are comparable to where we were last year. October was a bigger spending month than earning. Bingo brought in \$700 and Chipotle \$500. Two categories where budgets have been used up: Community Events and School improvements. If needed, will use reserve and make note for next year. The board approved the written checks.
