- 1) **Welcome and Introductions** Bridget called meeting to order at 7:10pm.
 - Parent guest gave feedback on non-inclusive feeling at Coleman. K parents are not finding ways to get involved. PTO shared ways to reach out to get all parents more involved. Idea: set up specific meeting and invite K parents to meet mentors.

3) **Principal's Report** – *Mike Taylor*

- Report cards are starting. Dec 22nd they will come home. Mr. Taylor will read each one.
- Two jobs open at Coleman: 1) Instructional Assistant with Special Education, dealing with IEP, 2) Instructional Assistant with ELD Students, needing language support. 22-25 hours/week. No prior experience needed. Interview process to start in 2 weeks.
- Money available for below grade level students. Idea; Hire teachers to work with students before school for kids who need extra support. Focus on literacy. Will propose to teachers soon. Starting Jan 10.

4) **PTO Business** — *Bridget Radachy*

- Spending \$7,000 Enrichment
 - o Mural Project moving forward (\$3,500). Kids were invited to meet and learn about a mural and started sketching ideas.
 - Brainstorming on remaining \$3,500 results Speaking with kids to get ideas: culture club (international foods, etc), gaga pit, fashion class, cinematography, tinkering club, garden, yoga, survival. Classes free of charge, after school. To be continued...
- Changes to instructional minute schedule for 2017/2018. Will come out in early Dec. Increase in instructional minutes for K-5. Don't know what this will look like. K day will get longer, up to 50 mins. Will not affect curriculum, will be used for free play, emotional development. This was piloted at Glenwood and no advantage to be found. After care will also be affected. Why are they doing this? Request for district to be more transparent about this at meeting on Jan 17, SRHS Library at 6pm. To be continued...
- Mindfulness Meeting- December 5, 2016, to develop proposal. Meeting with experts who will conduct teacher/parent/student trainings on campus. Goal is to help kids to be cognizant of feeling and not reacting right away.
