7. Dads Group — Kenneth Pledger

- Crab Feed is coming on 1/27 and is second largest fundraiser for Coleman at ~\$18,000. This comes from ticket sales, games and mostly silent auction items.
- Trying to cull down the list of Silent Auction items to the ones that bring in 80% of revenue.
- 180 people are expected to attend.
- Marketing is done. Eyan Higgins-Jones created a poster. Rebecca will hang around school.
- PayPal button is on PTO website and ready to accept payments.
- Venue is booked, same band and DJ as last year.
- Wine is secured. Volunteer signup still needs to go out.
- Need a floor manager to run the Silent Auction.
- Need decorators and a leader of the Games (wrist bands and push the heads/tails game).
- Big sellers for Silent auction is the home makeover, parties, sports tickets and vacation homes (if you know of anything let Ken know). Should add donation request to Coleman Connect.
- Send out a Silent Auction Catalog from auction software in advance of the event.
- Live auction piece needs improvement. Maybe auctioneer on table with mike in middle of room? Raise the paddle idea, to donate \$ around a specific need. Coleman should really only have 1 big ask like this per year. And is this the best place to do it? Don't want to dilute for last push at APD. We've decided to hold off and look at it for next year. There are other venues for doing something like this. Also think collaboratively and look at all pieces of fundraising at the crab feed.
- Buy tickets via PTO website. Have Abby send out mention to grade level reps, especially Kindergarten families. Kenneth can dress up in crab outfit and hang at drop-off and Kindergarten lot.
- Idea of crab and tiger having a dance off!
- Overall, the event is in good shape!
